Agenda Items:

1. Final Report on 20-21 LANDTrust budget plan.
2. Amendments for 21-22 LANDTrust plan
 - a. **Reason for the Amendment:** Provide teachers and staff additional time and support with curriculum planning and intervention support.
 - b. **Amendments to Action Plan:** Along with current Action step 5, 6 and 8 teachers will engage in outlining curriculum, use of technology, intervention plans, and pacing guides for the 22-23 school year. This will be a continuation of our PLC work.
 - c. **Reallocate to LANDTrust Budget:** Reallocate \$10,000 from 300-Purchased Prof/Tech services and \$19,000 from Computer Supplies to 131-Salaries - Teachers.
 - d. Discussed Special Ed teachers, and additional para's and classified employees that would also need to be included in the planning. Mrs. Anderson will follow up with teachers and get a final list of teachers who will want to participate after the school year ends. We will look at the list and plan the allotted stipend amount based on those numbers. Jemma motioned to vote. 6 members FOR, 0 Against, 3 Absent.
3. Family Game Night Planning:
 - a. Discussed having food items for families, an activity chart of some sort that students can use to check-off locations and activities they have engaged in.
 - b. PTA is working to involve different community cultural performances. Mrs. Voorhees is also working on songs for students to perform.
 - c. Next meeting we will finalize locations.

- d. We will get feedback from students of their top 3 favorite HUGO party activities and make sure those are part of the game rotations. We will also incorporate a favorite PE activity that students choose.
- 4. Additional conversation about Bullying and behavior at School:
 - a. Jemma asked what is being done to address bullying at school. We discussed our PBIS plan. (can be found here <https://horizon.murrayschools.org/horizon-elementary-behaviors/>) Discussed programs such as Bullyology and skills groups that are happening with Social Workers and Assistant Principal.
 - b. Discussed possible mitigation strategies and difficulty with the amount of behaviors we are seeing from students, even at a young age.
